## Design a Summer Library Badge

Each year during our Summer Library Program at the Sheldon Public Library, readers earn badges for reading and doing activities. This year we're looking for badge ideas from you! We are looking for 3 new badge ideas that will be part of our Summer Library Program for all readers to earn.

For example, last summer kids could earn a badge called "Cook with a Book" by making 3 recipes from a library cookbook. The badge looked like this:



Badges can be for reading different kinds of books, reading books about certain things, doing a specific activity, writing a book review, or anything that helps kids learn and have fun over the summer. This year's summer theme is Read, Renew, Repeat, so anything related to the Earth, animals, recycling, or caring for our world would fit perfectly, but you don't need to limit yourself to the theme.
